

Directions to Cathedral Pines Park, Middle Island, NY

From the South:

From the New Jersey Turnpike take exit 10 to Route 440 east toward the Outerbridge Crossing. Continue on 440 into Staten Island. On 440 go east on 278 over the Verranzano Bridge to Brooklyn. Cross the Verranzano and take the exit for the Belt Parkway. Go east on the Belt past Kennedy airport. At the split, take the Cross Island Parkway North. Continue on this until the Long Island Expressway.* Go east on the LIE to Exit 66, Sills Road. Go left at bottom of the exit ramp. Continue ahead. Bear left on Patchogue-Middle Island Rd. Follow road to right at traffic light. and left on RT. 21 North, Yaphank-Middle Island Rd. Entrance to Cathedral Pines on left.

From the North:

Take the Throgs Neck Bridge south to the Clearview Expressway south, to the Long Island Expressway (495). *Take the LIE east and continue as above

From Northern New Jersey:

Take the George Washington Bridge east to the Major Deegan Expressway South. Take route 87 south to the Triboro Bridge to Queens and Eastern Long Island . Go east on the Grand Central. Stay on this road, it will change to the Northern State Parkway. Continue on the Northern State Parkway and take the exit for LIE East. *Continue as above. RV's and Trailers go 95 east till exit for Throgs Neck Bridge and go south on the Clearview Expressway to the Long Island Expressway. Take the LIE east
Note: Parkways in New York City and Long Island are for passenger vehicles only. No trailers or commercial vehicles are allowed. Use Expressways.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility

problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.

- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

There is no training in the ring at a CPE agility trial. First offense will result in an excusal from the run. Further offenses will result in additional excusals for the day/weekend per the judge's discretion. This is for the safety of the dog.

The following items *are not* considered training in the ring (also see FEO):

- Dog grabbing it's leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

The following items *are* considered training in the ring:

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

Upon acceptance of this entry, I / we agree to hold Canine Performance Events, Inc. and its members and officers, this Host Club, its members, directors, officers, agents, show secretary, show chairperson, show committee and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, any sponsors of this event, harmless from any claim or loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog or handler while in or upon the show trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I / we further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether any claim be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Host Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. Exhibitors must verify their entry information from the club's confirmation and report any entry discrepancies to the show secretary before the closing date; and move up discrepancies before the move up date for the trial. The show secretary is not obligated to make changes at the trial if it is the exhibitor's error.

No changes to results (except a club's scoring error) will be made once the trial has been completed when the handler did not report an entry or move up error.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- * It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, including weather conditions.
- * Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current CPE Rulebook.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. Entries with incorrect ID numbers may not be accepted, nor will entries for dogs less than 15 months old on the trial date.

There will be no measuring of dogs after the judge's briefing begins each day. All dogs without a permanent height card must be measured before showing that day, even dogs entered at 24". There will be no exceptions.

Prizes & Awards: Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Title ribbons will be awarded for Class Titles.

Please help us keep this wonderful site by exercising your dog responsibly and picking up after your dog at the show site, and hotels. All dogs must be on leash except in the ring or warm-up area.

POLICIES

- No entries may be accepted after the closing date, May 13, 2010. Notification of move-ups must be received, in writing, by **May 24, 12 Noon**, either by email to jgcollier51@yahoo.com, or by mail to Sheila Mittenmeyer, Trial Secretary, (106 Vanderbilt Ave., Central Islip, NY 11722).
- **Confirmations will be sent by email**, from jgcollier51@yahoo.com. Please add this address to your contact list so your confirmation is not rejected as spam. **If you would like a written confirmation, you must enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.**
- **There will be no refunds** for entries withdrawn **after** the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for dismissal.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of a Judge or the Trial Committee.
